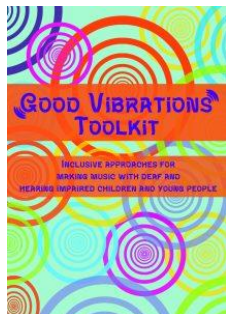

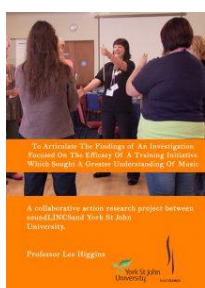
**Groove and Grow** - In Lincolnshire we have been working with Bishop Grosseteste University and Young Parents in the care system which has culminated in a report -

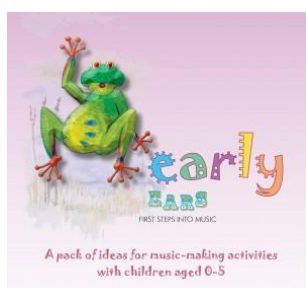
